The U.S. 3rd Fleet's Area of Operations is approximately 50 million square miles of the Eastern and Northern Pacific Ocean, encompassing the waters from the West Coast of the United States to the International Date Line. It includes the Bering Sea, the Aleutian Islands, and a sector of the Arctic Ocean.
